In this 2022 Annual Report, we share with you the results of a year in which FUTURE FOR YOUTH FOUNDATION worked to build a brighter future for young people.

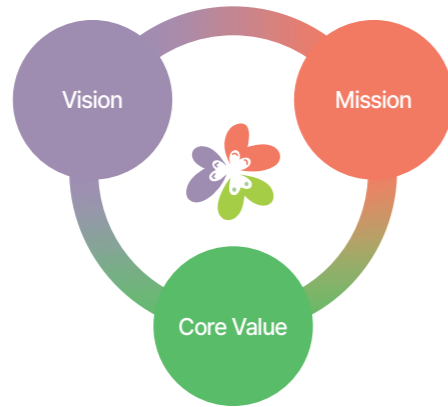

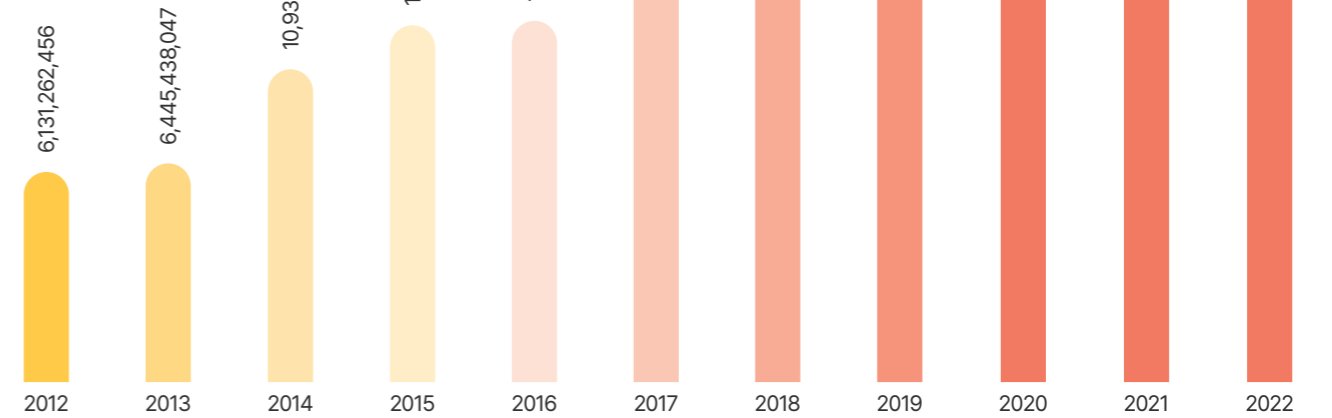
Donation Status HISTORY

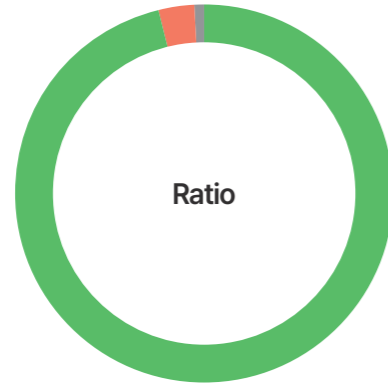

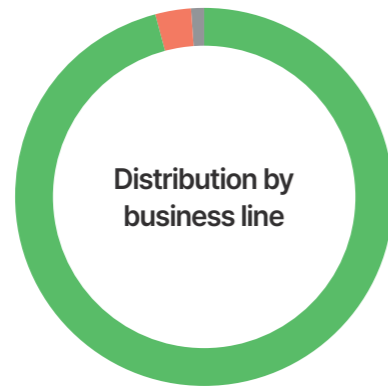

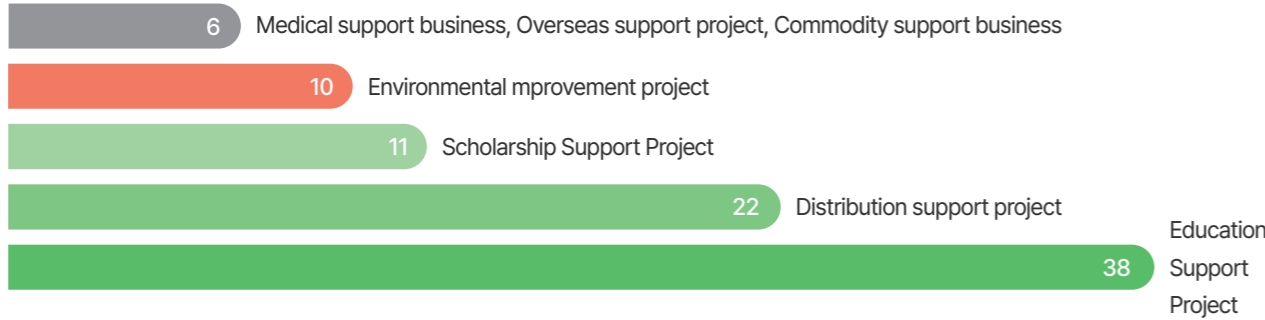


Foundation projects by business sector

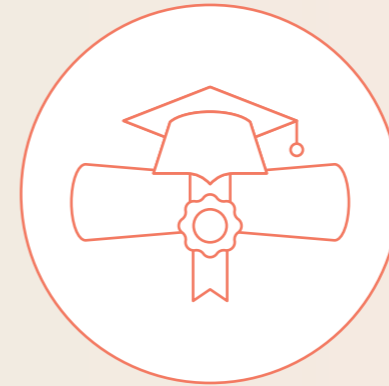
2022 Social Contribution Projects (CSR)

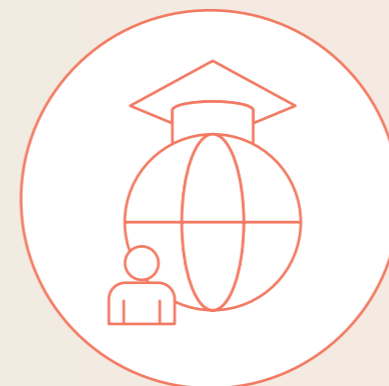

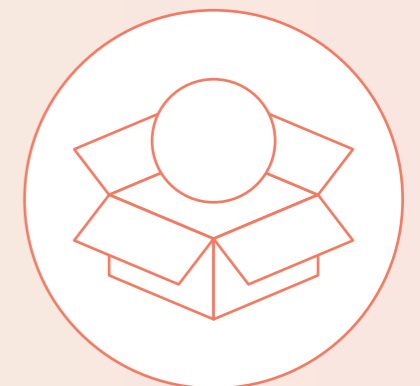
